DJ is to monitor use of the Bubble Machine, keeping check on hazards such as proximity of children and safety of the flooring in front of the machine. When setting up, DJ to consult with Event Contact if DJ considers the use of the Bubble Machine to be safe considering the flooring of the location. DJ can decide to not use the Bubble Machine if deeming it is unsafe to do so.
Lollies, bubble liquid, and prizes	Ingredients	Allergic reactions	Rare	Major	Medium	Event Contact has responsibility to alert Funtime Kids Parties at least a week before the event of participants who might have allergies that could be affected by common ingredients in bubble liquid, lollies, and toys. Event Contact is to provide DJ with lolly prize packs (at own expense) if there are specific allergies not ordinarily taken into consideration by Funtime Kids Parties. Funtime Kids Parties do not use lollies or liquids that have common allergic reactions. Funtime Kids Parties will inform the DJ if there are special requirements, such as no bubbles, or that the lolly pack will be provided by the Event Contact.
